



"Facts & Figures" was hailed by critics and earned him a Yamaha endorsement. Songs from his LP, "Todd Alsup" were featured on MTV and PBS. His single "The Only Thing" won the OutMusic Award for Pop Song of the Year. His third studio album, "Currency" was recorded in Switzerland with Orlando Ribar. Todd has a close-knit group of fans affectionately known as THE TODD SQUAD. His other solo project "Freedom: The George Michael Experience," has wowed audiences all over the world. ROB RUGGIERO (Director) has been a vital part of TheaterWorks Hartford's artistic leadership team for the past 30 seasons. 
